- 1. All entry forms to be sent to the Horticultural Secretary.
- 2. <u>All entry forms must be received by noon, Friday 18th August 2023. Entries</u> received after this time are at the discretion of the organisers.
- 3. All Exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor and must have been grown by him / her.
- 4. Seedmen's agents, Professional Florists or those connected in any way with Nurseries are prohibited. Commercial caterers or those connected in any way with catering are prohibited.
- 5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and in the event of such refusal, it is not required that any reason or explanation be given.
- 6. Any protest must be made in writing and given to the secretary within one hour of the judging along with a deposit of £5.00 which will be forfeited if the protest is found to be frivolous. All protest and questions of dispute shall be referred to the committee whose decision shall be final and from which there shall be no appeal legal or otherwise.
- 7. The decision of the Judge shall be final on the relative merits of the exhibit.
- 8. After judging has taken place no exhibit or part of an exhibit may be altered or removed until the time specified, except by special permission of the Secretary.
- 9. All exhibits, personal property, etc. shall be at the risk of the exhibitor and the Society shall not be liable for compensation for loss or damage from a cause whatsoever.
- 10. All exhibitors must pay the admission fee onto the Showground.
- 11. Exhibitor Entry Cards will be issued on the morning of the show. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to ensure that Entry Cards are placed together with their Exhibits.
- 12. Staging may be commenced from 6pm until 9pm on the Friday evening and from 8am on the morning of the show. All entries must be in place by 9.45am
- 13. Judging will commence at 10am. No person shall be allowed in the Marquee during the Judging, except those officially engaged. The public will be admitted to the Marquee once judging is complete (approximately at 1pm)
- 14. Presentation of the cups will commence at 4pm. All cups are to be held for one year only and should be returned at least 30 days before the day of the show and in the same condition as you received them. Please note that all cups will always remain the property of Llandeilo show should a class disband.
- 15. Prize money will be handed out following the presentation on Show Day. Any prize money not collected will be given back to the show.
- 16. No exhibits shall be removed before 4.00pm. The Committee will not be responsible for any entries left in the Marquee after 5.30pm.
- 17. Exhibitors are at liberty to offer their produce for sale after 4.30pm. This ruling does not apply to the Cookery Section in accordance with Food & Hygiene regulations, Cookery Section Exhibitors are prohibited from selling their entries to the public but are permitted to take them home for their own or their family's consumption.

Ingredients:

Pastry:
125g Plain Flour
Pinch of Salt
25g cold butter, diced
25g lard
2 tablespoons milk

Filling:
125ml Milk
175ml double cream
2 medium eggs
1 tablespoon chopped fresh tarragon,
Salt & Pepper
100g grated cheddar cheese
180g cooked spinach, lightly chopped
60g cooked broad beans or soya beans

Method:

- 1. To make the pastry...
 - a. Sieve the flour and salt into a bowl; add the fats and rub the mixture together using your finger tips until you get a sandy, breadcrumb like texture.
 - b. Add the milk a little at a time and bring the ingredients together into a dough.
 - c. Cover and allow to rest in the fridge for 30-45 minutes
- 2. Lightly flour the work surface and roll out the pastry to a circle a little larger than the top of the tin and approximately 5mm thick.
- 3. Line the tin with the pastry, taking care not to have any holes or the mixture could leak. Cover and rest for a further 30 minutes in the fridge.
- 4. Preheat the oven to 190°C.
- 5. Line the pastry case with greaseproof paper, add baking beans and bake blind for 15 minutes, before removing the greaseproof paper and baking beans.
- 6. Reduce the oven temperature to 160°C.
- 7. Beat together the milk, cream, eggs, herbs and seasoning.
- 8. Scatter 1/2 of the grated cheese in the blind-baked base, top with the chopped spinach and beans and herbs, then pour over the liquid mixture.
- 9. If required gently give the mixture a delicate stir to ensure the filling is evenly dispersed but be careful not to damage the pastry case.
- 10. Sprinkle over the remaining cheese. Place into the oven and bake for 20-25 minutes until set and lightly golden.
