HORTICULTURAL SECTION: RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. All entry forms to be sent to the Horticultural Secretary.
2. **All entry forms must be received by noon, Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2024. Entries received after this time are at the discretion of the organisers.**
3. All Exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor and must have been grown by him / her.
4. Seedmen's agents, Professional Florists or those connected in any way with Nurseries are prohibited. Commercial caterers or those connected in any way with catering are prohibited.
5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and in the event of such refusal, it is not required that any reason or explanation be given.
6. Any protest must be made in writing and given to the secretary within one hour of the judging along with a deposit of £5.00 which will be forfeited if the protest is found to be frivolous. All protest and questions of dispute shall be referred to the committee whose decision shall be final and from which there shall be no appeal legal or otherwise.
7. The decision of the Judge shall be final on the relative merits of the exhibit.
8. After judging has taken place no exhibit or part of an exhibit may be altered or removed until the time specified, except by special permission of the Secretary.
9. All exhibits, personal property, etc. shall be at the risk of the exhibitor and the Society shall not be liable for compensation for loss or damage from a cause whatsoever.
10. **All exhibitors must pay the admission fee onto the Showground.**
11. Exhibitor Entry Cards will be issued on the morning of the show. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to ensure that Entry Cards are placed together with their Exhibits.
12. Staging may be commenced from 6pm until 9pm on the Friday evening and from 8am on the morning of the show. **All entries must be in place by 9:30am**
13. **Judging will commence at 10am.** No person shall be allowed in the Marquee during the Judging, except those officially engaged. **The public will be admitted to the Marquee once judging is complete (approximately at 1pm)**
14. **Presentation of the cups will commence at 4pm.** All cups are to be held for one year only and should be returned at least 30 days before the day of the show and in the same condition as you received them. Please note that all cups will always remain the property of Llandeilo show should a class disband.
15. Prize money will be handed out following the presentation on Show Day. Any prize money not collected will be given back to the show.
16. No exhibits shall be removed before 4.00pm. The Committee will not be responsible for any entries left in the Marquee after 5.00pm.
17. Exhibitors are at liberty to offer their produce for sale after 4.30pm. This ruling does not apply to the Cookery Section - in accordance with Food & Hygiene regulations, Cookery Section Exhibitors are prohibited from selling their entries to the public but are permitted to take them home for their own or their family's consumption.

#### **Judge's Recipe - Macarons**

Ingredients

For the macarons:

170g/6oz icing sugar

160g/5¾oz ground almonds

120g/4¾oz egg whites (from 3-4 medium free-range eggs), divided

160g/5¾oz granulated sugar

1 tsp powdered raspberry-pink food colouring (or other colour of your choice)

For the raspberry chocolate ganache filling:

120ml/4fl oz double cream

110g/3¾oz dark chocolate, finely chopped

25g/1oz unsalted butter, softened at room temperature

75g/2½oz raspberry jam

## Method

1. Preheat the oven to 170C/150C Fan/Gas 3½.
2. Line 2 large baking trays with greaseproof paper. (A clever thing to do is to have a template with evenly spaced circles that you can slip under the greaseproof paper when piping the macarons; then you can just slide it out when you are finished and re-use it.)
3. Blend the icing sugar and ground almonds together in a food processor until really smooth. Sift the mixture into a bowl. If there are quite a few big pieces of almond, tip it back into the food processor and pulse it a few more times.
4. Sift the almond mixture into a bowl and stir in two of the egg whites to form a smooth paste.
5. Whisk the remaining two egg whites in the bowl of a freestanding mixer until stiff peaks form when the whisk is removed.
6. Meanwhile, stir 50ml/2fl oz water and the sugar in a saucepan over a medium heat until the sugar dissolves. Bring to the boil until it reaches 118C/244F (check this with a sugar thermometer).
7. While whisking the egg whites on high speed, slowly pour in the sugar syrup, being careful not to pour the hot syrup onto the beaters as it could splash up. Continue whisking for a few minutes until the meringue has cooled slightly, and is warm, but not hot, to the touch. The meringue should be glossy, and form beautiful peaks when the whisk is removed. Whisk in the pink food colouring until the meringue is evenly coloured.
8. Fold the meringue into the almond mixture until smooth (be careful not to overmix). Spoon the mixture into piping bags and pipe 4cm/1½in rounds onto the baking trays. Knock the trays hard on the work top to get any big bubbles to rise to the surface and pop.
9. The macarons must stand for 20-30 minutes before going into the oven as it helps to form a skin. (The macarons can rest for 1-2 hours.)
10. Bake for 13-15 minutes until risen and set.
11. Remove from the oven and set aside to cool. Carefully peel the macarons off the greaseproof paper.
12. For the raspberry ganache filling, heat the double cream in a saucepan until just boiling, then remove from the heat.
13. Pour the cream over the chopped chocolate and stir until the chocolate has melted and the mixture is smooth.
14. Stir in the butter and raspberry jam. Spoon the ganache into piping bags and set aside to cool.
15. Pipe a small amount of ganache onto half of the macarons and sandwich together with the remaining macarons.
